\* In order to receive “Full Stewardship” rate, new families must complete a stewardship visit within 30 days of registration.

- Tuition accounts paid in full **by April 15, 2007, (or upon registration thereafter)**, will receive a 5% discount.
- No tuition discount will be offered unless fees are current.
- Currently registered students will not be allowed to re-register unless fees and tuition payments for 2006-2007 are up to date, and volunteer commitments are current.

Capital and Activity Fees due by April 15, 2007. A \$25 per month late fee will be assessed on all fees not paid by that date.

The Capital fee supports building and remodeling expenses for all school facilities. Activity fees are for bus rental, tickets and other fees associated with field trips and in-house presentations. A payment plan for fees may be arranged by contacting Shari Pender, Finance Director, at 570-0070, ext. 77, **prior to February 1, 2007.**

Registration fee and completed SMART Tuition contract, and voided blank check are due at the time of registration. Upon payment of tuition in full, your original contract and check will be returned to you.

***Activity and Capital Fees are due on or before April 15, 2007.***

No refunds will be made of Registration or Capital Fees. Activity Fee will be refunded if you move out of the area prior to September 1<sup>st</sup>. A 50% refund of the Activity Fee will be made if you move out of the area prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Tuition may be paid in full by April 15, 2007, for a 5% discount, or may be paid monthly through the SMART tuition management program. ***If you choose to use the SMART program, your tuition will be deducted automatically, from the account you designate, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month, July 2007 – April 2008.*** A completed Smart Tuition form must be completed and on file in the school office in order to complete your child's registration. If tuition is paid in full by April 15, 2007, your contract will be returned to you. Financial Aid is available by submitting an application to FACTS Grant Aid and Assessment Company. Forms are available in the school office. Contact Gael Gormaly, Financial Aid Coordinator, at 570-0070 ext. 74, for more information.

Students who enter St. Catherine's after October 1<sup>st</sup> will be eligible for a pro-rated tuition, based upon the number of days remaining in the school year. Fees remain the same. Late registrants have the option of making a payment directly to the school to offset tuition contract amount, or of making larger payments for fewer months. All tuition contracts must be paid in full by April, 2008.

Students registering, who will begin attending at a later date, will be required to pay tuition from the time of registration in order to hold their place.

**SUPPLIES:** A supply list will be mailed with other welcome back information in the summer mailer. Students are expected to bring in their supplies the first week of school.
